Post COVID-19 pamdemic saw another two big events. The First Science, Technology and Innovation Forum co-hosted by IISc Bengaluru in India and the first Japan Immersion Programme for the students of Indian Institute of Management Kozhikode in Japan. IJL was chosen by JST as the first host university to Indian students for Sakura Science Programme 2023 to inform those Indian students about higher education opportunities in Japan. IJL has been invited by NEDO second time to join their programme as the only private university from Japan. 
